Dear Friends of FIGS.

Thank you for your support! Your gifts in 2017, enabled FIGS to provide 19,000 prescription medicines and medical supplies for uninsured and under-insured Wake County residents, at no cost to them.

Our neighbors stay healthier and are able to maintain employment and more stable lives due to our provision of payment for their needed medications. We **FILL IN THE GAPS!** We partner with Urban Ministries Crisis Support, Open Door Clinic and Alliance Medical Ministry where clients are interviewed and eligibility is determined. Vouchers for needed medicines are issued to our cooperating pharmacies who have agreed to charge us the lowest possible prices. Prescriptions are filled at no charge to the client, and FIGS reimburses these pharmacies for the prescriptions. We also purchase generic medications that are dispensed at the Open Door Clinic Pharmacy.

In 2017, FIGS received a Community Grant from the Foundation of Hope to provide medications and transportation for our neighbors with mental health issues. This transportation enables them to keep their doctors' appointments and access pharmacies to receive their required medications.

FIGS re-branded with a new logo and website, www.figsofwake.org, to better reflect the work we do and improve outreach. We connect with donors, partners, and clients via Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn. Be sure to follow and like us there!

None of what we do would be possible without the continued support of people like you who contribute to this important mission. We keep our administrative costs low so that 95% of the funds received are used to purchase needed medication and medical supplies.

COLLABORATION: Building an effective health care support system cannot be achieved alone. We strive to be a role model through our willingness to share information and resources.

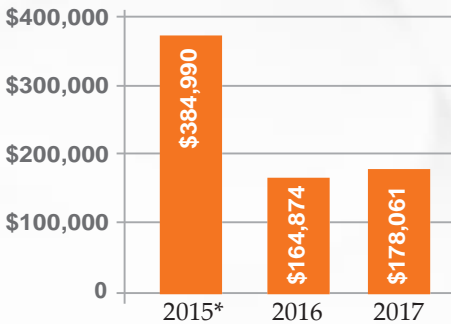

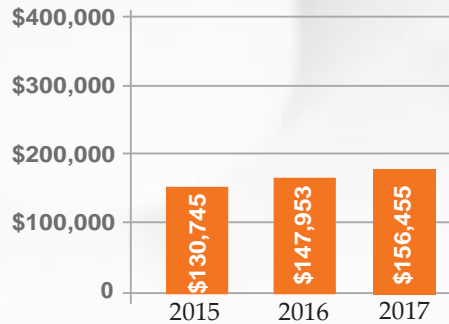

Valerie has been a patient of Urban Ministries of Wake County's Open Door Clinic for nearly ten years, where she sees her doctor regularly and her prescriptions are filled at no cost thanks to Filling In Gaps (FIGS). Before coming to the Open Door Clinic, Valerie was going to the Emergency Room anytime she was sick enough to justify the visit, racking up huge amounts of debt.

Valerie suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, neuropathy, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), and migraines. "I would be lost without FIGS," says Valerie, mentioning that she would be forced to go without the medication that helps her to live a higher quality of life.
