2020 was a year like no other. The COVID-19 pandemic impacted every aspect of our lives. Through our faithful partners, FIGS was able to continue to fulfill its mission despite the challenges. Because of our generous donors, who amazingly increased their giving during a time of financial crisis, we were able to fund all our work. Thank you!

Providing prescription drugs to the uninsured has always been and continues to be at the heart of FIGS' mission, but in recent years we have expanded our scope to include critical medical supplies such as glucometers, asthma inhalers and CPAP machines, preventives such as flu shots, over-the-counter medications, and transportation to medical appointments to get the prescriptions we fill. We also underwrite the operations of the mobile health clinic of the UNC School of Nursing two days a month.

In 2020 we provided over 20,621 prescriptions to over 5,183 Wake County residents. We worked closely with our prescription voucher partners: NeighborHealth, Alliance Medical Ministry, Dorcas Ministries, and the Urban Ministries Crisis Intervention Center. We provided funds for the bulk purchase of generic drugs by the Urban Ministries Open Door Clinic.

Despite the challenges 2020 presented, FIGS' continuity is a testament to our donors, partners, volunteers, staff and our working board. Our goal is to keep overhead expenses low, so that the lion's share of donations goes directly to client services.

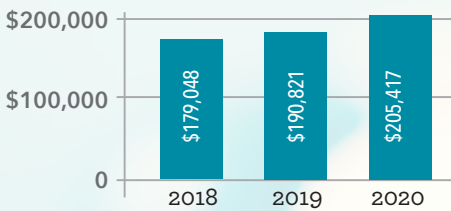

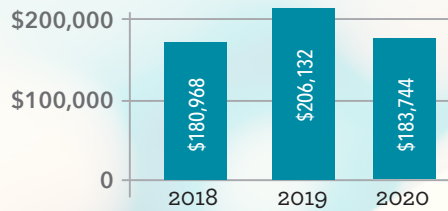

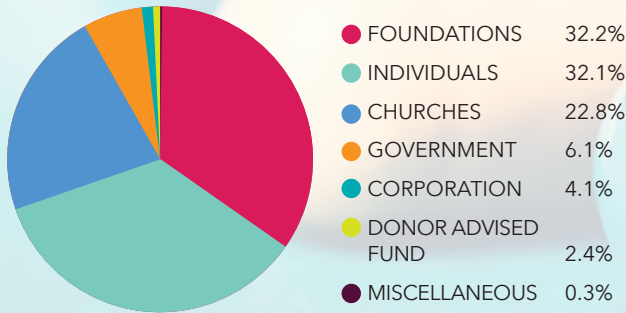
### 2018-20 REVENUE



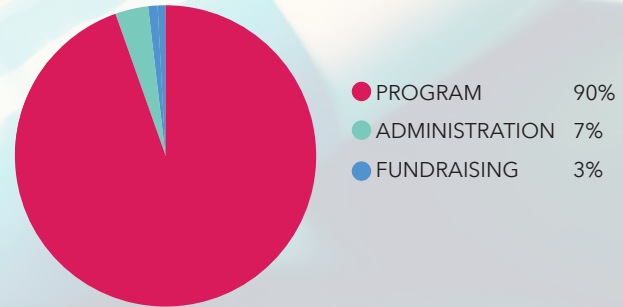
### 2018-20 EXPENSES
